203. Photographs from Siberia **\$24.95**
JPEG images of 223 photographs that were sent from Siberia. The majority were on display as part of the Hope and Spirit exhibit. Others were found and identified after the program ended.

204. Letters from Siberia: including the Sepetys letters **\$64.95**
PDF files of 226 letters that were sent from Siberia. The majority of the letters displayed as part of the Hope and Spirit exhibit. In addition, letters that were found after the program ended are included. These additional letters include a set from Jonas Sepetys, the grandfather of Ruta Sepetys, the author of Between Shades of Gray. This CD also contains 91 envelopes sent from Siberia, 16 itemized receipts of packages sent to Siberia, and 2 extensive personal memoirs.
